KEEP ATTACHED RULES

RANGE SAFETY RULES

- 1. No alcoholic beverages allowed on the course at any time.**
- 2. Anyone suspected of being intoxicated will be asked to leave. This is a judgement call by the officers present.**
- 3. Archers will shoot only in designated areas. Broadheads will only be shot in the broadhead pit.**
- 4. While shooting the course archers will follow the designated trail. No short cuts permitted, even if a target has been passed up.**
- 5. Archers will leave one person of their group at the designated shooting point while recovering arrows. This will ensure the following group knows people are still in the target area.**
- 6. A maximum of five minutes is allowed to search for lost arrows.**
- 7. Anytime an unsafe act is observed, a call of "CEASE FIRE" will be made. Once the problem is corrected, call out "CLEAR" and resume shooting.**
- 8. Report any safety violations to any Club Official or field captain.**
- 9. If in doubt, don't shoot! Don't be afraid to ask if a target is "ALL CLEAR" Communicate and be safe.**
- 10. When drawing a bow back, there can be no excessive movement, such as swinging left, right, or up. Shooters who do so may be disqualified and asked to leave the range.**
